most important portion of the essay.)

3. What specific challenges or barriers did you overcome to make your initiative a reality?

4. How many people have been involved with or affected by your leadership initiative described in question number two? (Tell us how far and wide your impact has been!)

5. Describe examples of how your initiative has been successful in positively impacting Native American youth. (Examples are very helpful for the application review committee.)

6. What are your dreams for your leadership initiative? How do you want to see your initiative sustained and/or expanded?
